The High Commission wishes to inform that following His Excellency President Nana Addo Dankwa Akuffo Addo's 23rd Address to the Nation on Sunday, 31st January, 2021, the following measures are to be noted and strictly adhered to, for entry into Ghana to all prospective travellers:

- The cost of covid-19 test for inbound Ghanaians and ECOWAS Nationals will be pegged at **Fifty United States Dollars (US\$50)** at the Kotoka International Airport.
- The cost of care at isolation and treatment centres for all Ghanaian will be borne by the Government;
- The government will bear the cost of mandatory isolation and treatment of Ghanaian Nationals who test positive upon their arrival into Ghana;
- Efforts are being made by the Government of Ghana to procure safe vaccine for the entire population beginning with the delivery of seventeen million, six hundred thousand (17.6 million) doses of vaccine for Ghanaians by the end of June 2021, with the earliest consignment of vaccine expected by the March 2021.
